The National Great Rivers Museum in Alton, IL is once again seeking entries for a Mississippi River photography contest. The winning entry will be used as a photo mural in the museum's exhibit gallery. Photos should be landscape oriented scenes of the Mississippi River taken between Saverton, MO and Cairo, IL.

To submit an entry, please send a high quality print of your image, along with this completed form and a fully signed and executed release, found on the back of this flyer. Any entries submitted without a release will be disqualified.

Although we are requesting a hard copy of your photo for evaluation, if chosen, you must be able to provide a digital file that meets the following specifications:

- Minimum size: 9x14" @ 300 DPI, no upsampling (sizing-up with Photoshop or similar software)
- Ideal format is .raw, but .jpg & .tif will also be considered
- RGB Color
- If using a scanned photo, the original must be high quality, free of dust, and scanned at 3200 DPI at the photo size

You may submit multiple entries to the contest. Entries must be received on or before 05/31/2010 to be considered. If your picture is chosen, you will be notified by 06/4/2010.

The prize for winning is that your image will be displayed as an 8'h x 18'w mural, with credit given to the photographer.
